Bell Block based Box Office Boxing Club received a grant of \$26,000 towards re-roofing their clubrooms, purchasing new equipment and setting up a new boxing ring. In the past four years the Club's membership has increased dramatically and continues to attract new members.

TARANAKI YOUTH HEALTH TRUST (WAVES)

WAVES Youth Centre provides youth programmes, a meeting place, and free youth health services for people aged 10 to 25. The centre is visited by hundreds of Taranaki young people each year. Originally located on Gover Street, WAVES outgrew that location and with the help of a \$73,000 grant from the Trust relocated to Powderham Street.

NEW HEALTH CENTRE IN STRATFORD

Stratford Health Centre is the result of years of community effort to establish a more secure future for the provision of primary health care services in the Stratford District.

Stratford Health Trust received a grant of \$200,000 towards establishing the new \$2m centre which brings community medical services, practitioners and DHB services together in a one stop shop. The centre's service delivery rooms are a hive of health related activity with midwives, audiologists, physiotherapists, doctors and specialists now operating from the centre.



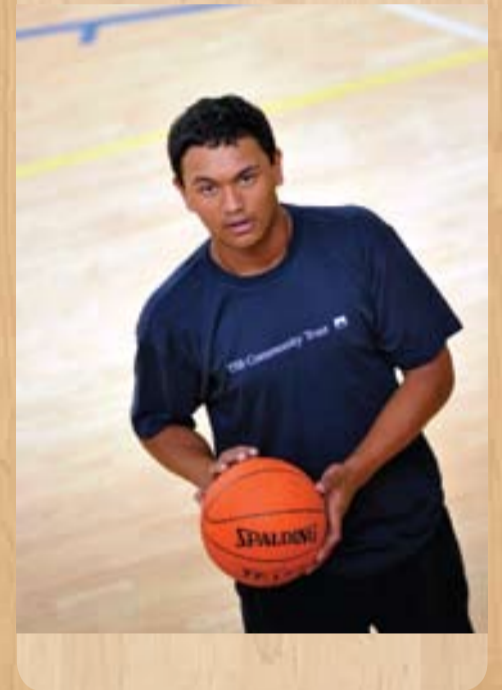
ORCHESTRAL CHIMES

CHAIR'S REPORT 2011

To our esteemed peoples, leaders and communities.

Greetings, greetings, greetings to one and all.

This is my last Chair's Report for the TSB Community Trust – after three terms (12 years) with the Trust I am retiring and my term ends in May 2011. During the time that I have been with the Trust there have been many changes, not only within our own community but within the nation and the wider world in which we live.

Closer to home, the Trust has grown immensely in the past 12 years; the staffing alone has gone from one part time Manager working from home to a dedicated office with 2 full time and 3 part-time staff members. In my first year as a Trustee the Trust paid out \$1.7m in grants, compare that to the \$6.3m that was paid out in grants in this financial year, you get a true sense of the growth the Trust has been through in the past 12 years.

In that time the Trust has funded all manner of community activities and projects through the applications process. We have also implemented some of our own exciting projects and initiatives, such as our Literacy

project now in its 7th year, our Numeracy project now in its 3rd year and more recently our Maori health workforce development project - Whakatipuranga Rima Rau.

As always, this has been a busy year for the Trust in regard to our general community grant-making. This year the Trust granted close to \$6.3m towards all types of activities – ranging from everyday small community activities to significant projects. On top of this the Trust has pledged in excess of a further \$1.4 million.

2011 Dividend

Yet again the TSB Bank Ltd has done us proud with a dividend payout of \$9.05 million.

It was only two years ago, when several Community Trusts were unable to distribute funds into their communities because of the international financial crisis. That did not happen with the TSB Community Trust because the TSB Bank Ltd was enjoying phenomenal financial performance as a result of superb financial management. Consequently this community has yet again reaped the benefit of that success.

There are many regions that remain envious of the additional community funds that our area enjoys as a consequence of the consistently high performance of our TSB Bank Ltd. We remain proud and positive of the Bank and thank Mr Kevin Murphy, his management team and all staff for the stellar effort they put in.

Trustee Appointments

This year the Trust welcomes Trustee Keryn Broughton to the governance table in June for her first term with the Trust. Keryn brings many skills with her as a local Barrister and has a strong community connection having worked as a volunteer at the Community Law Centre and Citizens Advice Bureau.

The Trustees have recently elected Hayden Wano to the position of Chair and Marise James to the position of Deputy Chair. Both will take over these positions as of the 1st of June 2011. I have the utmost faith in both appointments and feel comfortable in the knowledge that the Trust's future is in such safe, visionary and capable hands.

Moving Forward

The Trust continues to implement the Strategic Plan 2009-2013 and is positioning itself to work strategically with our communities. The Trust is poised and ready to move towards outcome based funding and will look to engage with organisations on collaborative community led projects.

Farewell and Thank You

One of the highlights of my three terms has been the opportunity to get to know our community and all those that hold it together. The volunteers in this community are vital in maintaining the intricate fabric of our society, without them Taranaki would not be the positive go-ahead place that it is. So many of you give of your time freely, you are the true heroes of our community


and often go unnoticed; I'd like to take this opportunity to thank you all for all that you do.

GRANT DISTRIBUTION 2010/2011

During the 2010/11 financial year a total of \$6,295,154 was distributed by the Trust. This, together with previous distributions compromises a total of \$68,471,445 worth of assistance to the Taranaki community over the past 23 years.

This level of grants is possible because of the strong support and growth of the TSB Bank Ltd which is reflected in the dividend paid to the TSB Community Trust, the Bank's sole shareholder/ owner, on behalf of the people of Taranaki.

GRANT APPLICATIONS

As at the 31st March 2011, in total TSB Community Trust made grants to 907 organisations and individuals during the year. Twenty four applicants had grants pledged, nine applications remain deferred awaiting additional information and a total of 23 applications were declined. In accordance with Trust policy since its

inception, the aim again was to assist as many community organisations as possible with an annual grant, while making special major grants to a number of significant projects.
